

**REQUEST FOR CONSULTANT QUALIFICATIONS  
REHABILITATION OF THE BLAIR COVERED BRIDGE  
OVER THE PEMIGEWASSET RIVER – CAMPTON, NH**

ADDENDUM #2

Clarifications to the Request for Consultant Qualifications (RFQ) to completely rehabilitate the Blair Covered Bridge over the Pemigewasset River.

Consultant questions:

- 1) What additional information will be requested of the three firms to be provided in the RFP, which is not being provided or requested in the RFQ? In other words, what information should the consultant not include in the RFQ submittal, and submit later in the RFP if shortlisted?

Ans. The sub-committee will review the RFQ submittals, shortlist the consultants and determine at that time, based on the RFQ, what will be required of the shortlisted consultants for the RFP.

- 2) The Town has outlined a three step process:
  - a) RFQ submittal
  - b) Shortlist and RFP submittal
  - c) Interview and selection

Can the Town waive the RFP submittal, and shortlist and interview based on the RFQ submittal? The Town has indicated a rigid and aggressive time frame. Waiving the RFP step would save time and get the Consultant on board earlier to prepare Phase I Preliminary Design.

Ans. The Town of Campton will require a RFP from the shortlisted Consultants. The Town of Campton reserves the right to waive the interview and select the Consultant based on the RFP.
