TOWN OF CAMPTON PLANNING BOARD MEETING MAY 9, 2017 MINUTES

The Planning Board met this date with Stuart Pitts, Chairman, Greg Jencks, Secretary, Chris Kelly and Jay Pafundi, Alternate.

Stuart Pitts opened the meeting at 6:30 PM.

First on the agenda, the Work Session notes for the April 4, 2017 Planning Board meeting. Greg Jencks made a motion to approve the Work Session notes, as amended, for the April 4, 2017 Planning Board meeting. Chris Kelly seconded the motion. The Planning Board voted in the affirmative, unanimously.

Next on the agenda, the Work Session notes for the May 2, 2017 Planning Board meeting. Greg Jencks made a motion to approve the Work Session Notes for the May 2, 2017 Planning Board meeting. Chris Kelly seconded the motion. The Planning Board voted in the affirmative, unanimously.

Next on the agenda, Greg made a motion to make Jay Pafundi a voting member for this meeting. Chris Kelly seconded the motion. The Planning Board voted in the affirmative, unanimously.

Next on the agenda, Matthew Albee from 5 Town Pound Road. Matthew wants to open a Disc Golf Course to the general public around the beginning of May, 2017. The course will be called White mountain Disc Golf and it is going to be a 9-hole course located on the land at the end of the dead- end road. Disc golf is a sport-like golf, where you try to finish the round in the least amount of throws, but instead of a club and ball hit into a hole, you throw frisbee-like discs into baskets. It is fun, competitive, and inexpensive outdoor recreational sport that is gaining popularity in this area. The parking will be at the end of the dead- end road. The cost will be \$5.00 a round and \$8.00 per day. The course will be open from dusk until dawn during the months with no snow on the ground. Matt said that there would be no lighting and signage to start. Stuart told Matt that the Commercial Zone goes 500 feet back, and to bear in mind that if 200 people are parking and using the golf course then people may complain.

Greg Jencks made a motion to approve the White Mountain Disc Golf, Site Plan Review. Chris Kelly Seconded the motion. The Planning Board voted in the affirmative, unanimously.

The Planning Board told Matthew that they wished him well in his new venture.

The Planning Board adjourned at 7:30 PM.
