AN ORDINANCE VOTED BY THE SELECTMAN TOWN OF CAMPTON NEW HAMPSHIRE

13-0001 RELATIVE TO: REGISTERED OFFENDER RESTRICTIONS

A. Definitions

- 1. Registered Offender -- This chapter shall apply to offenders who have been convicted of the crime against a person under the age of 18 and as a result, are required to register pursuant to RSA 651-B:6 I.
- 2. School/Day Care --Any public or private educational facility that provides services to children in grades K-12 or licensed day care facility that is clearly marked. This shall include all property owned, leased or controlled by the educational or day care facility.

B. Restrictions

1. Any person who is a registered sex offender involving a minor, and is required to register with the State of New Hampshire as defined above is prohibited from entering upon the premises of a school or day care center, unless specifically authorized by the Chief of Police, school administration or day care center administration.

C. Penalties

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine not less that \$250.00 and any subsequent violations of this chapter by the same person shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$500.00. The Town may also seek injunctive relief to require compliance with the provisions of this ordinance. The Town shall be entitled to an award of reasonable attorney's fees and costs if it is the prevailing party in any action to enforce this ordinance.
