TOWN OF CAMPTON, NEW HAMPSHIRE

ROAD WEIGHT LIMIT ORDINANCE EASTERN CORNERS ROAD

1. WEIGHT LIMIT ESTABLISHED

Pursuant to RSA 41:11 and RSA 231:191 the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Campton, upon recommendation of the Town Road Agent that such posting is required to prevent unreasonable damage or extraordinary municipal maintenance expenses as a result of intensification of logging, excavation, construction and other activities involving heavy vehicles, hereby establish the following weight limits for that section of Eastern Corners Road, a Class VI town road, beginning at the Westerly side of the Bridge to the end of the Class VI road:

A weight limit of ten (10) tons, applicable all year

2. NOTICES TO BE POSTED

Notice of the weight limit shall be posted at the entrances of the restricted portion of Eastern Corners Road. Such signage shall be legible, posted in a conspicuous location, and be of weather resistant materials.

3. EXEMPTIONS, FEE

The Board of Selectmen reserve the right to grant exemptions from the above weight limit for limited times and purposes upon specific application. Any person seeking such an exemption shall apply to the Selectmen upon such form as the Selectmen prescribe and such permit may be issued if in the opinion of the Selectmen or their designee the issuance of the permit will not be detrimental to the preservation of the Town road nor detrimental to public safety. In issuing such permit, the Selectmen may attach such conditions as they deem to be in the best interests of the public including, but not limited to, the establishment of bonding, or other acceptable surety and restoration requirements. The fee for each such permit shall be \$50.00.

In addition to the exemption provisions stated above, the Board of Selectmen may exempt some or all of the following categories of vehicles from the operation of this Ordinance: Town Highway Department vehicles, Fire Department vehicles, emergency vehicles while going to and from the scene of an emergency, commercial solid waste disposal vehicles, oil or gas delivery vehicles, postal vehicles, and school buses.

4. PENALTY

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a violation if a natural person, or guilty of a misdemeanor if any other person and in addition, shall be liable for the cost of restoration of the highway to a condition satisfactory to the Board of Selectmen or its designee.

5. REPEAL

All prior ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
