The Campton Campus Design Committee met in the Campton Community room to hold their monthly meeting on Wednesday, June 14, 2023, at 2:30 pm. Minutes Review

The Board reviewed the minutes from May 10, 2023; The Board mentioned changing the wording on line 23 and adding information on the talk of a new website. Sherrill Howard motioned to approve the minutes as amended, Mary O'Brien seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Police Chief

Chief Foss presented his current and future needs to the board. He first discussed the need for a Sally Port. A Sally Port would provide security, safety, separate male and female locker rooms, a separate booking room, additional office space, and storage space. Chief Foss is continuously looking for funding that may come available for his department to help with Sally Port's expenses. An engineering report is on file in the town office. Chief Foss explained that with the town's population growth, he anticipates the need to increase his staff. The national average employment for police is 2.5 employees per/thousand people. Chief Foss explained that he needs additional storage space. He currently stores the radar trailer in the Fire Department Sub-Station and uses the shed in the back of the campus. Uniforms and firearms are being stored in a locked office.

Treasurer & Deputy Treasurer:

The CCDC has asked Nancy Mardin, Treasurer, and Anna Hanrahan, Deputy Treasurer, to present their needs. Nancy explained that Corey provided her with an email and a new laptop for her work. Nancy would like to start training a 3rd signer for her position since she will be retiring at some point. She will continue to need to store documents and information.

Board Concerns & Directives:

Charlie Wheeler mentioned that he has not heard from Pike Industries. The lines of communication are still open. They have been busy.
